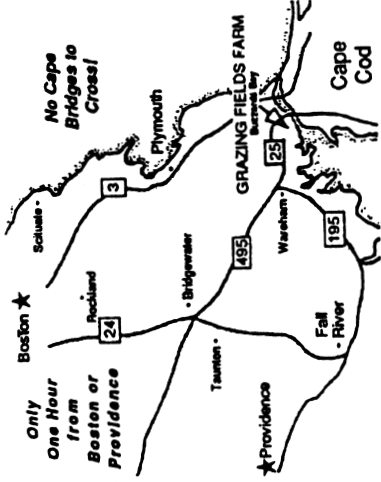

LIABILITIES AND DECISIONS

The Horse Show, its committee or employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any rider, groom, attendant, animal, equipment or spectator at the show. Should any question arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Management reserves the right to change the location of classes and to alter courses and/or fences, to change the show schedule, vary the list of invited officials, and/or add or cancel a class should the best interest of the Show be served. The Committee, further, reserves the right to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the show ring, and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation. If the entries in any two or more classes of the same division are not sufficient to fill them, the Committee reserves the right to combine the same into one competition.

PRIZE MONEY

A trophy and/or cash and eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Prize money will be deducted from your entry. If a refund is due, a check will be sent to the owner within 30 days of the show. Checks are good for 60 days only. Management will not be responsible for any lost or stolen checks.

DOGS

All dogs must be LEASHED. Loose dogs will be picked up and retained until the owner has paid a \$50.00 fine.

USEF RULES

The Grazing Fields Farm Horse Show Series is a local member of USEF. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Life, Senior Life, and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmembership registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes, 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motor vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above



described motor vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Entries close 12:00 noon each Thursday before the show. Any entries received after this time will be considered post entries and will be charged a \$25.00 post entry fee.

NOSMOKING PLEASE No smoking within 100 Feet of any tent or building.

Open to all Adult Amateur competitors. Riders shall perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Ten points to qualify (10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1). Riders **may** continue to show in this class once qualified.

60. MHC Adult Hunt Seat Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to Adult members of MHC. All contestants are to compete over a course of at least at least 8 fences, 2'6" to 2'9". One or more individual tests of the top four (4) contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1 - 19). At least four (4) riders must complete the course for points to be awarded. Ten points required to compete at the Finals (10, 6, 4, 2). Riders **may not** continue to show in this class after qualifying.

65. SEHA Adult Medal

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to Amateur Adult riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" - 3'0" including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least two (2) competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify. Once qualified you may still enter the class until August 1, 2010. After August 1, 2010 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

61. Ariat National Adult Medal

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to Amateur members of the USEF and CEF who are eligible to compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter Division at this show. **A rider may not compete at the same horse show in any Hunter or Equitation class in which the jumps exceed 3'3"**. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences not to exceed 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course, and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e., water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top four (4) riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1 - 19. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class.

62. NEHC Adult Amateur Hunt Seat Medal

Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to Adult Amateur members of NEHC. All contestants to compete over a course of at least at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four (4) contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1-19). At least four (4) riders must complete the course.

Open to all Junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year (except Novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year). To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2' 6". Riders may cross-enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the finals. To fill a class, at least two (2) competitors must complete the course. Ten points required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2010. After August 1, 2010 only those not qualified may compete in the class.

44. MHC Hunt Seat Mini Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to members of MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, not to exceed 2' 6". No combinations. One or more individual tests may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1-5). At least four (4) riders must complete the course for points to be awarded. Ten points required to compete at the Finals (10, 6, 4, 2). Riders may **not** continue to show in this class once qualified.

48. SEHA Mini Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to members of SEHA who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year and have not competed in any horsemanship class in which the rider is required to jump higher than 3' with the exception of the USEF Pony Medal. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, at a height not to exceed 2' 6". No combinations. One or more individual tests may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1-5). Contestants are **not** allowed to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS, MHC, NEHC and RIHA Medal, USEF Medal, USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class, at least four (4) competitors must complete the course. Ten points to qualify for the Finals (10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2). Once qualified you may still enter the class. If you have won the Mini Medal Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

45. WIHS Pony Equitation Qualifying Class Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to Junior members of USEF or CEF. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 jumps; course may include an in-and-out. Small ponies to jump 2'3"; Medium ponies to jump 2'6"; Large ponies to jump 3'. The same horse must be used in all phases, only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three (3) riders must complete the course.

One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF current Tests 1-19). At least four (4) riders must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the Finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for the preliminary classes; violation will forfeit eligibility for the Finals for that year.

53. Taylor Harris Insurance Services National Children's Medal Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to Junior members of USEF and CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3' 6". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences 2' 9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Hunter or Jumper type, and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles are not permitted. The top four (4) riders or 20% of first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests (USEF Tests 1-19). An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

54. MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal Class Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to all Junior members of the USEF who have not reached their 18th birthday. Applications for membership must be made directly through the USEF office, or through the steward prior to the class. Two or more tests of the top four (4) competitors are required. (USEF Tests 1-19). To fill a class six (6) competitors must complete the course.

57. NHSAA/ASPCA Horsemanship Class Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to Junior members of ASPCA who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be shown over at least eight fences, 3' 6". The under saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. To fill a class, six (6) competitors must complete the course.

58. Platinum Performance / USEF Talent Search Entry Fee: \$35.00

Open to U.S. citizens who are all members of the USEF who have not reached their 21st birthday, are Juniors or Young Riders, and are Amateurs under USEF/FEI rules. The over fences phase shall have a special course of at least ten fences, 3' 6" to 3' 9" in height with spreads to five feet. Wings shall be no wider than 36". The course must include a double and a triple combination with at least one spread fence in each. Two other spread fences are required elsewhere on the course, and an obstacle with water is recommended (will be obligatory in the finals). To fill a class six (6) competitors must complete the course.
